The tradition of honoring those who support public schools with the AEA Partners in Education Award continues annually. The award honors corporations, local businesses, individuals, or community groups that exhibit exemplary support for local public schools.

The award, created by the AEA Delegate Assembly, is a way to demonstrate our strong belief in the importance of community support to the success of our public schools. Winners of the award will be honored at the AEA Foundation's Salute to Excellence ceremony.

Each local association president may submit the name of a single individual or local organization worthy of being honored. Nominations are also accepted via email.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Who can be nominated?

- Humanitarian Organizations
- Civic Organizations
- Community Activists
- Corporate Partners
- Local Businesses
- Religious Organizations

Nominees should not include individuals or organizations that are a part of a public school system or directly engaged in education as their primary function. This award is not aimed at PTA or PTO organizations. This award is for organizations that have gone beyond their usual business activities to assist schools.

#### **GUIDELINES:**

The nominated organization, group, or individual must have done one or more of the following during the preceding twelve months:

- demonstrated positive support for public schools;
- had a positive impact on education in the community;
- made a significant contribution to education;
- demonstrated support for public schools through resources, contributions and/or assistance.
